Dear Cong. Conyers and Cong. Kucinich,


In individual telephone conversations with each of you, I was given to understand that you responded clearly and affirmatively to my request that you relaunch the single payer movement in Congress at a news conference that *you* would sponsor with other House supporters of HR 676 and leading citizen group advocates of full Medicare for all with free choice of doctor and hospital—a much more efficient and humane system.

These assurances were made several weeks ago, shortly after the vote to fix a broken system with a broken piece of legislation was sent to the White House. You may recall I took note of the utter dismay of many people and groups who supported HR 676 only to be abandoned by all 80+ supporters. If you want to rescue withdrawal and political cynicism, you need to restart what you believe in.

Are you going to announce this news conference, since both of you assured me that you would be in touch with one another about so doing?
